Transition School is an unpaid work study program, designed to support students with disabilities who have deferred receipt of diploma, in preparation for independent employment, by providing a rigorous curriculum and immersion model, by partnering with local businesses, focusing in the areas of hospitality, retail, and health care.

Program Description	Students with disabilities who have completed the academic requirements for a Standard Diploma (access points criteria) and who are in need of additional work related transition skills are eligible to apply for a post HS transition program. Students must defer receipt of diploma for a work study program. Students who have met criteria and been accepted, will need to withdraw from their zoned school and will be enrolled in ESE Transition. Each post high school transition class will have a teacher and at least one employment specialist.	Project SEARCH is a one year full immersive internship program for students with disabilities who have been determined eligible for services through Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) and have met all criteria and requirements for entrance into the program. This program is a partnership between VR, Magnify (the VR provider), the host business site, and OCPS. Students may enter Project SEARCH directly without participating in a post high school class but it is highly recommended for students to participate in at least one year at a post high school program. Each site has a teacher and an Employment Specialist	Students with disabilities who have completed the academic requirements for a Standard Diploma and who are in need of additional work-related transition skills are eligible to defer receipt of their diploma to participate in a work study program and apply to ESE Transition School. Selected students will need to withdraw from their zoned school and will be enrolled in ESE Transition School.
